Details of Training:

After qualification in 1999, I started my training as a house officer for one year at Alexandria University Hospitals. This year training included General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Accident and Emergency, Obstetrics, Paediatrics and Orthopaedics.

Following this year, I did three years Orthopaedic Registrar at EI-Hadra Orthopaedic University Hospital, from 27.11.01 to 26.11.04. This is a 400 beds hospital with the following departments: A&E, Trauma and cold Orthopaedics. I started my training by introduction to basics of fracture treatment, management of multiple injured patients, techniques of closed reduction of fractures and conservative treatment as well as open reduction and internal fixation using AO techniques. I was a member of the team that



used to look after accident and emergency where we used to receive all varieties of RTA and multiple injured patients.

In cold orthopaedics, I had been involved in the treatment of congenital deformities, poliomyelitis, joint replacement, tumour surgery, and bone and joints infections.

El-Hadra University Hospital is the only teaching orthopaedic hospital in the city of Alexandria. The hospital runs regular teaching sessions for MCh and MD candidates. This includes teaching ward rounds, clinical meetings, X-R conferences, and combined meetings with Radiology, Pathology and Oncology departments.

At the end of these three years, I had submitted my MCh thesis. The title of this thesis was "Management of metacarpal fractures of the hand with external mini-fixators". After submitting the thesis, I was allowed to go through MCh exam, which included written, oral and clinical viva. I passed the exam with excellent score.

Then starting from 22-6-2005 I worked as an Assistant lecturer in the Department of Orthopaedic surgery and Traumatology, Alexandria University. In addition to the regular teaching sessions mentioned above, I had a duty three days weekly in the form of clinical teaching for the under-graduate students. I started working on my MD thesis "evaluation of the results of cementless Metal on Metal hip replacement". I become more involved in joint replacement surgery, arthroscopic surgery, hip and pelvic surgery.
